1. Fees: \$80 per division + \$10 office fee

Saturday March 3, 2012 schooling \$35 if entered in show \$55 if not entered in show, all courses open and decorated. No other horses allowed unless schooling.

Saturday schedule: gates open at 8am, stadium course open for GAG 9am-11am, stadium course open for BN 11am-1pm, Nov stadium course 1pm-3pm, Training stadium course 3pm-5pm.

Lost pinny fee= \$35

Cancellation or refunds. In event of cancellation all fees returned less office and expenses. Before closing date refund except office fee, after closing date no refund. In case of ground being too wet to run XC, Willow Draw will have a CT; entry fee will apply to CT with a \$40 refund.

2. Tentative schedule- two dressage rings starting at 8:00 am. GAG and BN starting first, then Nov and Training. Stadium start GAG, BN, Nov, Training. **Wear XC vest and gear for stadium round** because there will be a short "breather" before XC start. GAG, BN, Nov, Training order XC.

3. Award- 1st-6th ribbons. Money back for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>. \$10 of entry goes to prize money split 50% first, 30% second, 20% third.

5. Stabling- limited stabling, priority given to those traveling \$25/night, bedding included (no outside shavings, extra can be purchased here, \$10 per bag) RV hookups available (4 available) \$25/night

10. Cross country: GAG 1000m@300mpm with 13 efforts; BN 1800m@300mpm with 15 efforts; Nov 1900m@350mpm with 20 efforts; Training 2100m@420mpm with 22 efforts. All courses challenging for level, most jumps are max height, GAG has water crossing and hill pass over, Nov has low bank into water
